PCIM Asia 2024 exhibitor applications and call for conference abstracts now open

Shenzhen, 30 October 2023. With PCIM Asia now regularly moving every year between Shanghai and Shenzhen, 2024 will see the leading exhibition in Asia for power electronics once again taking place at the Shenzhen World Exhibition and Convention Center, expanding to 20,000 sqm and expecting to host over 200 exhibitors. The PCIM Asia Conference, widely regarded the gathering point of power electronics professionals in Asia has announced the submission deadline for abstracts to be 4 March 2024.

The PCIM Asia Conference call for papers is now open, and abstracts should be submitted before 4 March 2024. Acceptance of these abstracts will be notified in May 2024 and the full papers should then be submitted by 20 June 2024. Topics this year will address a wide range of important areas from advanced power semiconductors to smart grid, packaging and more.
